We're delighted to announce that the World Rally Pass (WRP) for Wales Rally GB 2011 is now on sale from [www.walesrallygb.com](http://www.walesrallygb.com)

As one of our valued WRP holders from last year's event, we thought you might be interested in a little information about the enhanced format of the rally this year, which extends the event to four days (Thursday 10th to Sunday 13th November 2011) and covers more than 350 competitive miles across 23 stages throughout Wales.

Ticket holders for this year's event will be able to experience the forests in late autumn and the spine-tingling noise of a rally engine's notes bouncing off the mountainside while enjoying some of the most iconic stage miles ever to grace the World Rally Championship stage.

The WRP gives you access to all of those stages - from the legendary Great Orme Toll Road in North Wales to Halfway and Crychan near Brecon, as well as first come, first served access to the Monument Power Stage, which is open exclusively to WRP holders.

The Great Orme Stage gets the action underway on Thursday, 10th November in Llandudno, where two stages on the Great Orme Toll road - last used on the Lombard RAC Rally in 1981 - and one at Clocaenog - last used on the Network Q RAC Rally in 1996 - will make up the competitive mileage for the first day.

The Monument Power Stage, open to spectators for the first time this year, will be used twice on Sunday 13th November 2011, and it is possible the second running of the stage will play host to the deciding thriller of the whole rally and possibly the entire Championship.

Wales Rally GB 2011 marks the 13th and final round of the FIA World Rally Championship, which has seen the two Sebastiens - Ogier and Loeb - fight it out for top Championship points, closely followed by Ford's Mikko Hirvonen. This intensifying rivalry - which sees less than 40 points separating first from third at three quarters of the way through the season - could come to a head at Wales Rally GB.

The World Rally Pass remains at the 2010 price and, at just £99\*, is 34 per cent cheaper than it was in 2003 when the event became Wales Rally GB. A 10% discount voucher valid on all official Wales Rally GB merchandise will also be sent to also all World Rally Pass buyers.
