ACCREDITATION EXPLANATION

Wales Rally GB is the 13th and final round of the 2010 FIA World Rally Championship and has to apply strict criteria for media accreditation set out by the FIA, the international governing body of motor sport.

Please read the following guidelines carefully and make sure all the information requested is supplied with your accreditation application and it is posted to the appropriate address.

Failure to supply the requested information, or to sign the disclaimer, will delay the processing of your application.

Accreditation provides access to the media facilities in Rally HQ and the Service Park in Cardiff and designated areas in Special Stages.

News and information can be supplied, free of charge, before, during and after the event to journalists and publications who are unable to attend the rally, or do not qualify for accreditation.

3.1. UK Based Radio Stations

North One Sport allow Rally GB to nominate five (5) national/local radio stations to broadcast from the event. A Maximum of two (2) passes will be issued to each Station.

Applications for national/local radio accreditation should be submitted by Thursday 30th September to allow time for North One approval.

NB: National or local radio journalists who are unable to attend the event, can be provided with a free of charge news and results service. Please contact John Horton, National Press Officer, for details.

4. INFORMATION TO BE SUPPLIED WITH EACH APPLICATION

- a) A formal request for accreditation, written on the publication's official letterhead, signed by a Director of the publication or the Editor. Requests signed by clerical staff will not be accepted.
- b) A completed Accreditation Form (See Page 4).
NB: International Print Media & Photographers must use the accreditation form found on the FIA website; www.fia.com
- c) Written confirmation of the publications frequency and its circulation or readership figures.
- d) A current and original copy of the publication.
- e) Examples of all published material from the 2009 Rally of Great Britain, if either the applicant or the publication were accredited.

- f) Requests from freelance Journalists/Photographers must be accompanied by copies of their published work during the last 12 months, specifying the names of the newspapers / magazines in which the work has been published.

NOTE: c) and d) do not apply to major International press agencies.

e) does not apply to publications applying for the first time.

5. GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION FOR ACCREDITATION APPLICATIONS

- a) Up to a maximum of **three (3)** representatives per organisation will be considered for accreditation by the FIA. A separate application form should be submitted for each person to be accredited.
- b) To be accredited, a publication must:
- i) have a circulation size and quality that satisfies the criteria of the FIA.
 - ii) be on sale to the public.
- c) **Accreditation for Press Photographers:** The FIA provides 12 (twelve) photographer Tabards for UK-based Photographers. Priority will be given to national publications and agencies based on circulation, frequency and previous coverage of Wales Rally GB.
- d) Advertising, PR, marketing, or sponsor representatives are not eligible for accreditation.

Once applications have been processed by Wales Rally GB and approved by the FIA, a letter or email confirming successful accreditation will be sent to the applicant(s).

This letter must be produced when collecting passes at the event.

No pass(es) can be collected without this confirmation.
