

# 2011 Wales Rally GB National Provisional Event Information



## Format

- The rally will run between the visits of Wales Rally GB to all the Friday and Saturday stages
- An opportunity to compete on the same stages as the WRC star drivers
- 76 miles of Classic Welsh forest special stages and 217 road miles.
- Start and Overnight Halt at the Royal Welsh Showground, Builth Wells
- Finish ceremony at the Service Park on Saturday evening with the WRC Academy finishers

## Eligibility

This will be a National B status event. There will be classes for both historic and modern vehicles.

Cars must comply with MSA Regulation R46; Historic cars must comply with Regulation R49.

## Entries

Entry fee: £562.50 + VAT @ 20% = £675.00

The maximum number of entries is 70. If less than 80 entries are received for the International event, the number of National entries accepted may be increased. Entries will be accepted as follows:

- 25 entries are reserved for entrants who are taking part in the 2011 RACMSA Rally of Scotland National.
- The first 30 Wales Rally GB National entries received before the closing date will be automatically accepted on a first come first served basis.
- All other entries received prior to the final closing date, will be advised if they have been accepted once entries for the International event have closed (Wednesday 19 October).
- A maximum of 5 entries will be placed on a reserve list should any withdrawals be received prior to Scrutineering.

## Reconnaissance
