1. Reconnaissance Speed Limit

Competitors are reminded that the speed limit during reconnaissance is 80km/h (50mph). Radar equipment will be used by the organisers to monitor the speed of vehicles. Competitors should also be aware that there may be other traffic on the special stage routes during reconnaissance. Non-compliance will result in a penalty at the discretion of the Stewards.

2. Flame Resistant Clothing

Competitors are reminded that in all special stages including the shakedown all drivers and co-drivers **MUST** wear approved overalls, long underwear, balaclavas and gloves (gloves are optional for co-drivers) homologated to FIA 8856-2000 standard. (See FIA Appendix L Chapter III part 2.) Competitors not wearing such equipment may not be allowed to start a special stage, and any non-compliance will be reported to the Stewards.

3. Yellow Flags in Special Stages (Extract from FIA GPs Appendix III Art 3.2.3)

Competitors are reminded that on passing a yellow flag, displayed at a stage radio point, they must immediately reduce speed, maintain this reduced speed to the end of the special stage, and follow the instructions of any marshal or safety car drivers. Yellow flags will be displayed at all radio points preceding an incident.
