The Stewards received a report from the FIA Safety Delegate concerning the accident of car No. 91 in SS1 at Post 7.

The FIA Safety Delegate stated that on his first run by car (as weather conditions did not permit helicopter usage) he noticed that this particular corner was a sharp right one with an expanding radius after a straight and the spectators were in proper places with sufficient marshals both on the inside and the outside of the corner to ensure adherence to the safety requirements.

On hearing about the accident of car No. 91 he revisited the scene of the accident before the second running of the stage and concluded that car No. 91 was travelling too fast to take the corner and continued straight under a very heavy braking condition.

The car slid across a small ditch and was launched up the bank by a log in the ditch. Some spectators were on top of the bank. When the car hit the bank, the spectators slipped and fell on the bank.
Fortunately no serious injuries resulted.

The Stewards investigated the matter thoroughly, assisted by the FIA Safety Delegate in the presence of the Clerk of the Course and the Event Safety Officials.

The Stewards conclude that no fault can be attributable to the Organisers and under the circumstances

DECIDE

Not to pursue this matter any further.
